Their head cupper has even judged the 2011 UTZ National Coffee Competition in Comayagua, Honduras.

New Morning's cupping team continuously tastes coffees from around the world in search of great beans for the Misty Valley line. Only the very best coffee beans are tasted by their cupping team. These coffees are then carefully roasted, packaged and delivered fresh to IFD.

The name Misty Valley comes from a popular Ethiopian legend about the discovery of coffee. According to the legend, a goat herder named Kaldi found his goats frolicking and full of energy after eating the red fruit of the coffee shrub. Kaldi tried the fruit for himself and had a similar reaction. Misty Valley is the name of the valley where the goats first tried the coffee beanfilled red fruit.
